Weather is finally changing as Governor Mills & State Health experts start to adjust county by county health practices based on the best science available. I appreciate the concern for human life that Governor Mills and others have made their number one priority and trust that the adjustments now being made are with the best intentions for all of us in the great State of Maine. As we go into this weekend let me take a moment to update you on the following:

End 2019-2020 End of Year Dates –All school boards have approved the end of year plans:

- DISHS Seniors' last day will be **Friday, May 29th**
- PreK - 11 instruction for most students will end on **Friday, June 5th**
- Instructional interventions for some students will continue in the AM during the Week of June 8th between the hours of 8:00 -11:00 am Monday - Friday.
(Teachers will notify parents if we need your child involved.)

Meal Delivery GOOD News – The USDA has adjusted their expectations so that school districts can extend food deliveries until the end of June. All school board have now voted to approve this continuation and so the last delivery of breakfast and lunch will now take place **on Friday, June 26th**. **(We understand some families may want to discontinue food deliveries to their homes when the remote learning schedule ends. Please let your school's office know. Thanks!)**

Monday, May 25th is Memorial Day - Meal deliveries won't be made on this day. Schools will send Monday's meals on Friday, May 22nd. Please look for information from your school's principal about how deliveries that week may change. Thanks!

Schedule change for the Brooklin School and DISHS – All of our schools have differing needs and so it means that from time-to-time, school by school adjustments may need to be made. Based on student and family needs we will be reducing the student remote learning schedule at both of these schools to four days per week, Monday – Thursday, starting next week. Meal deliveries will not change. If you have any questions please contact your school's principal.

End of Year Activities – With the new guidelines from ME CDC and the ME Dept. of Ed now in place, each of our school boards has approved plans from principals on each school' end of year activities. For details and events, please watch for updates from your school's principal.
